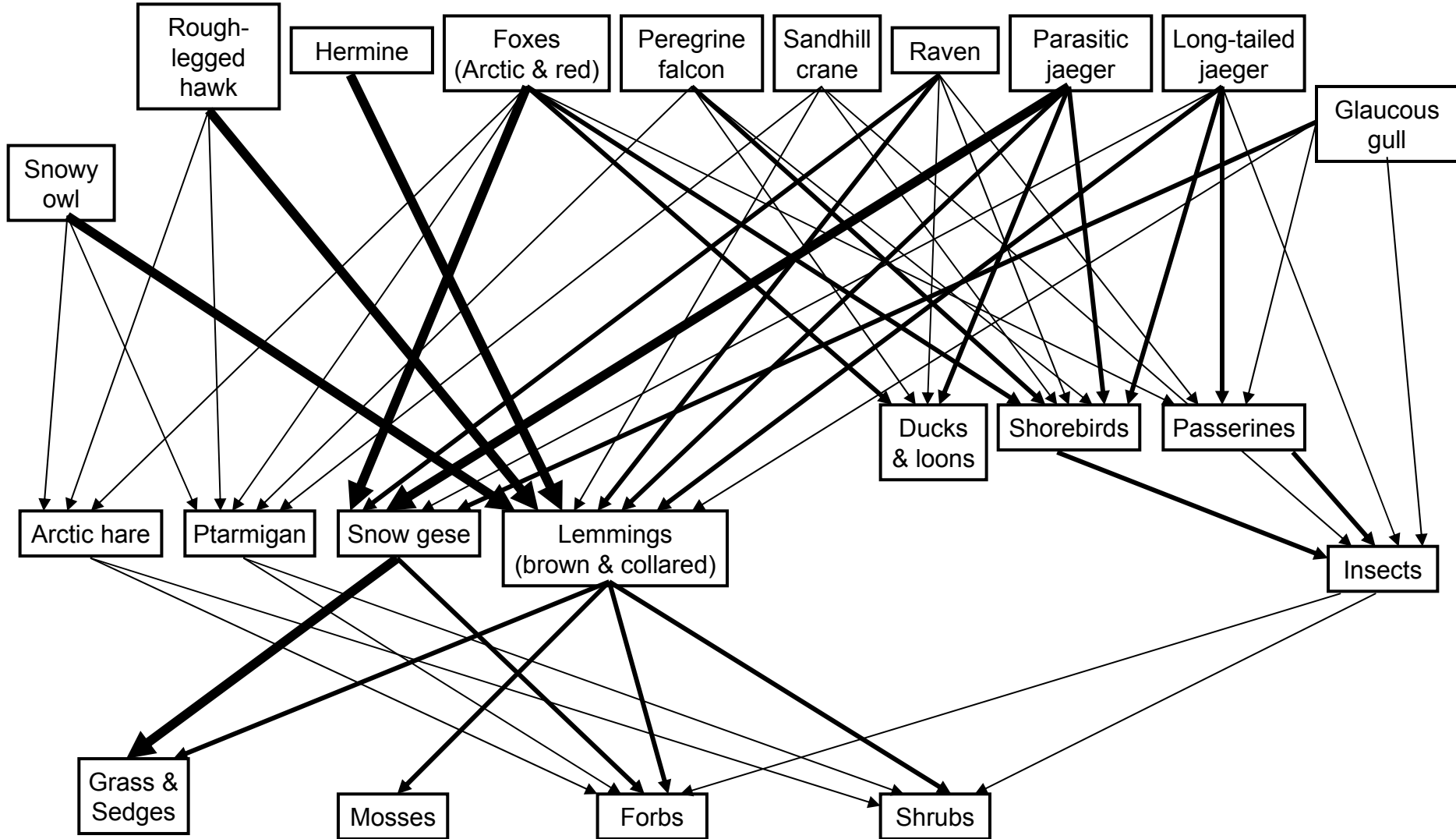
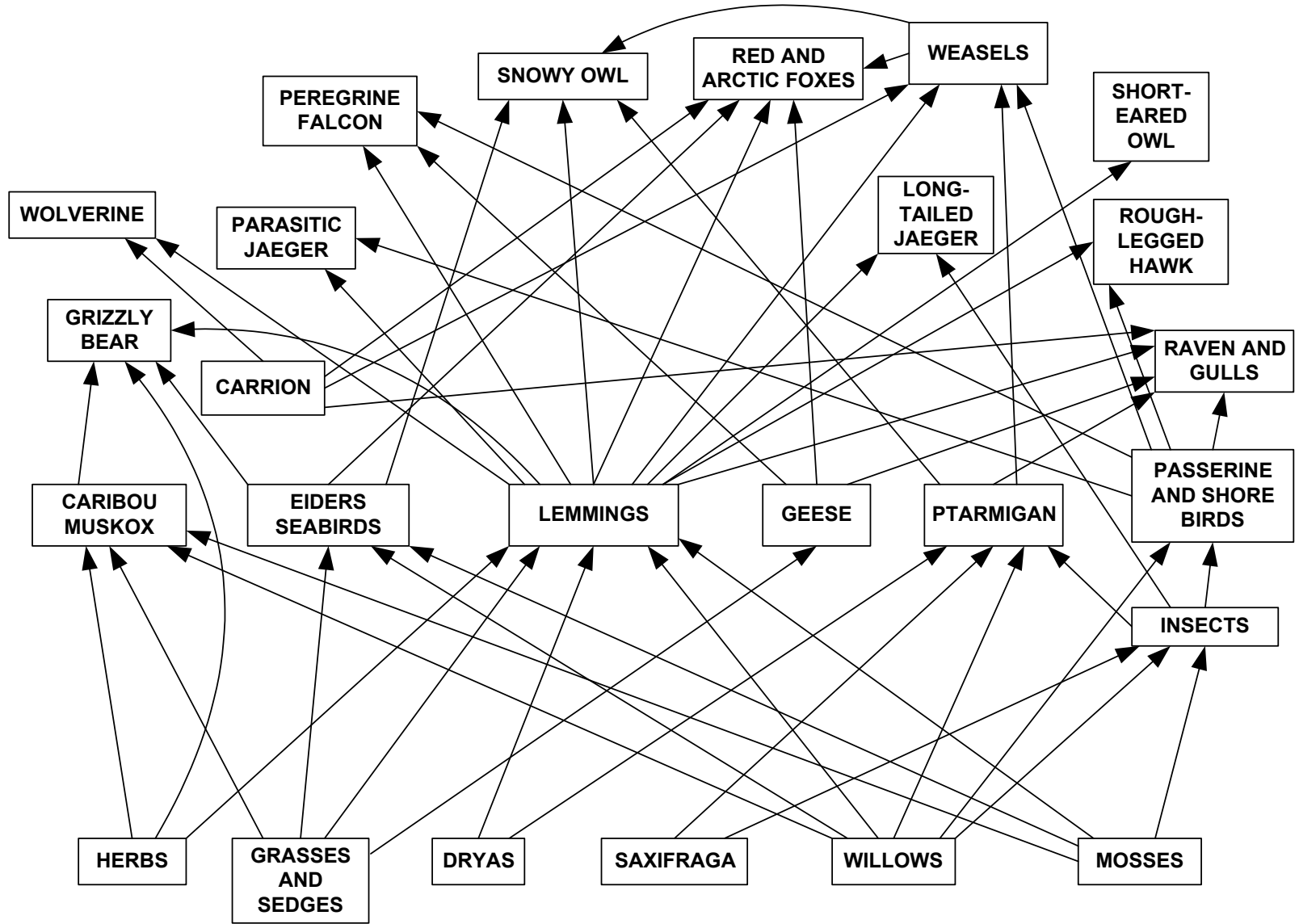


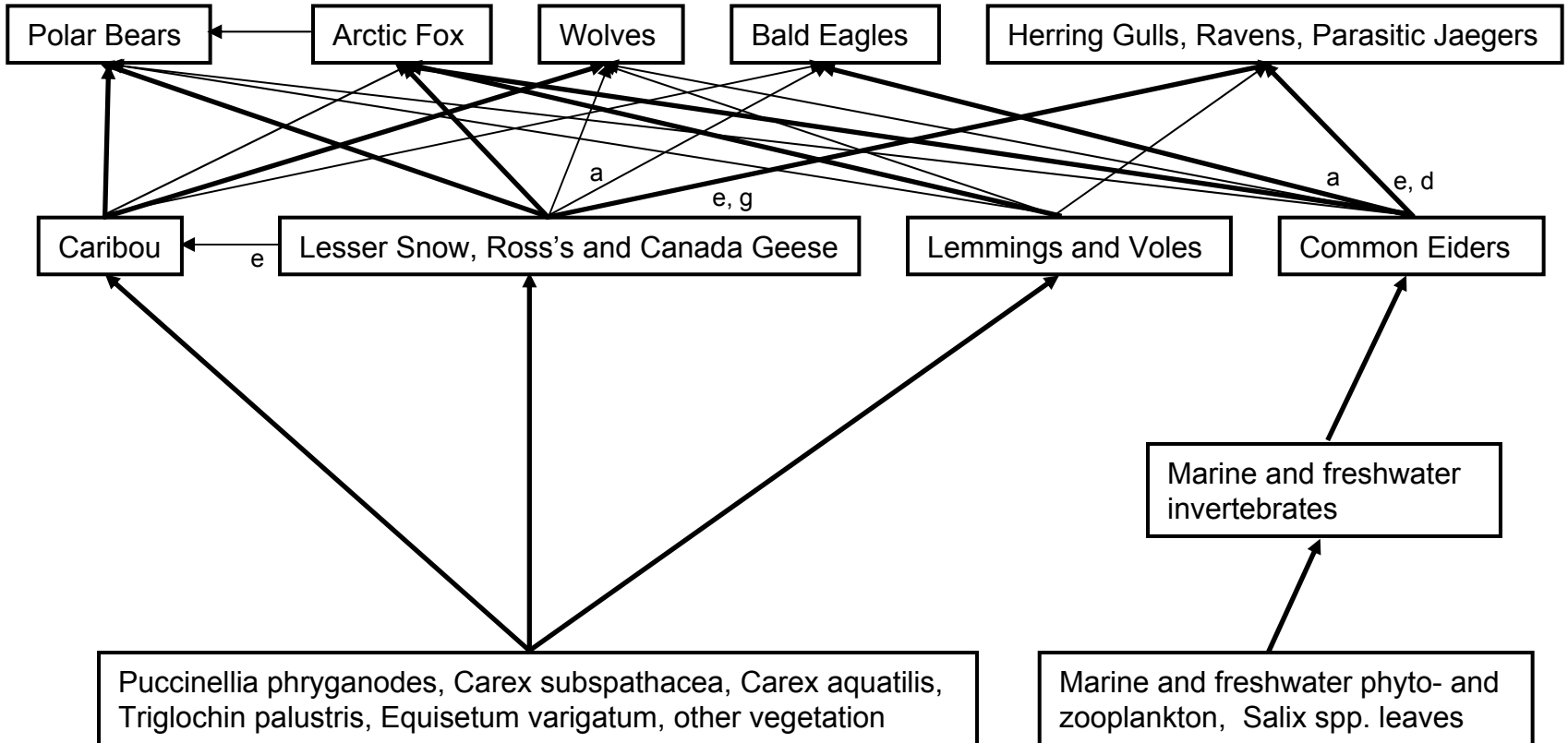

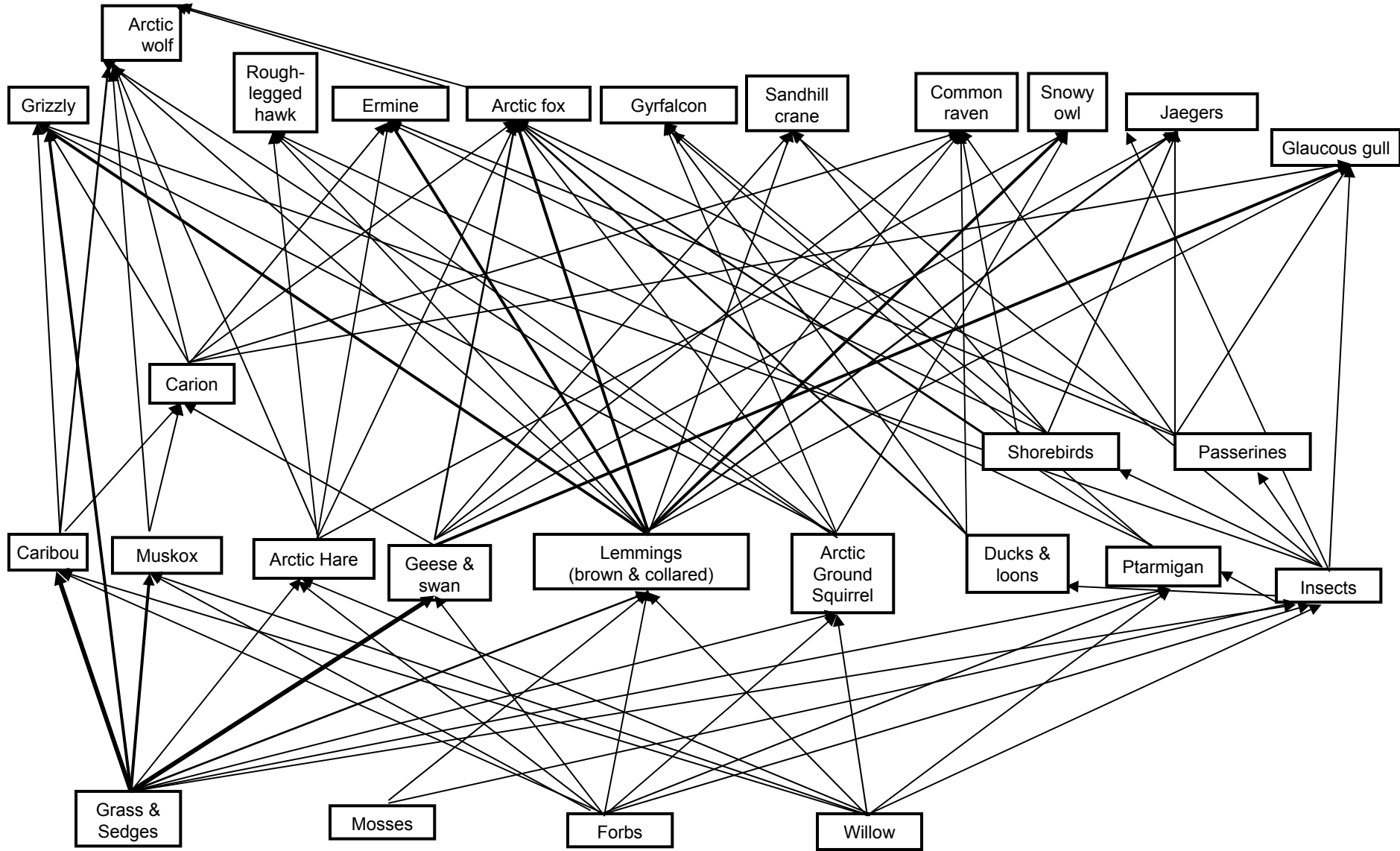

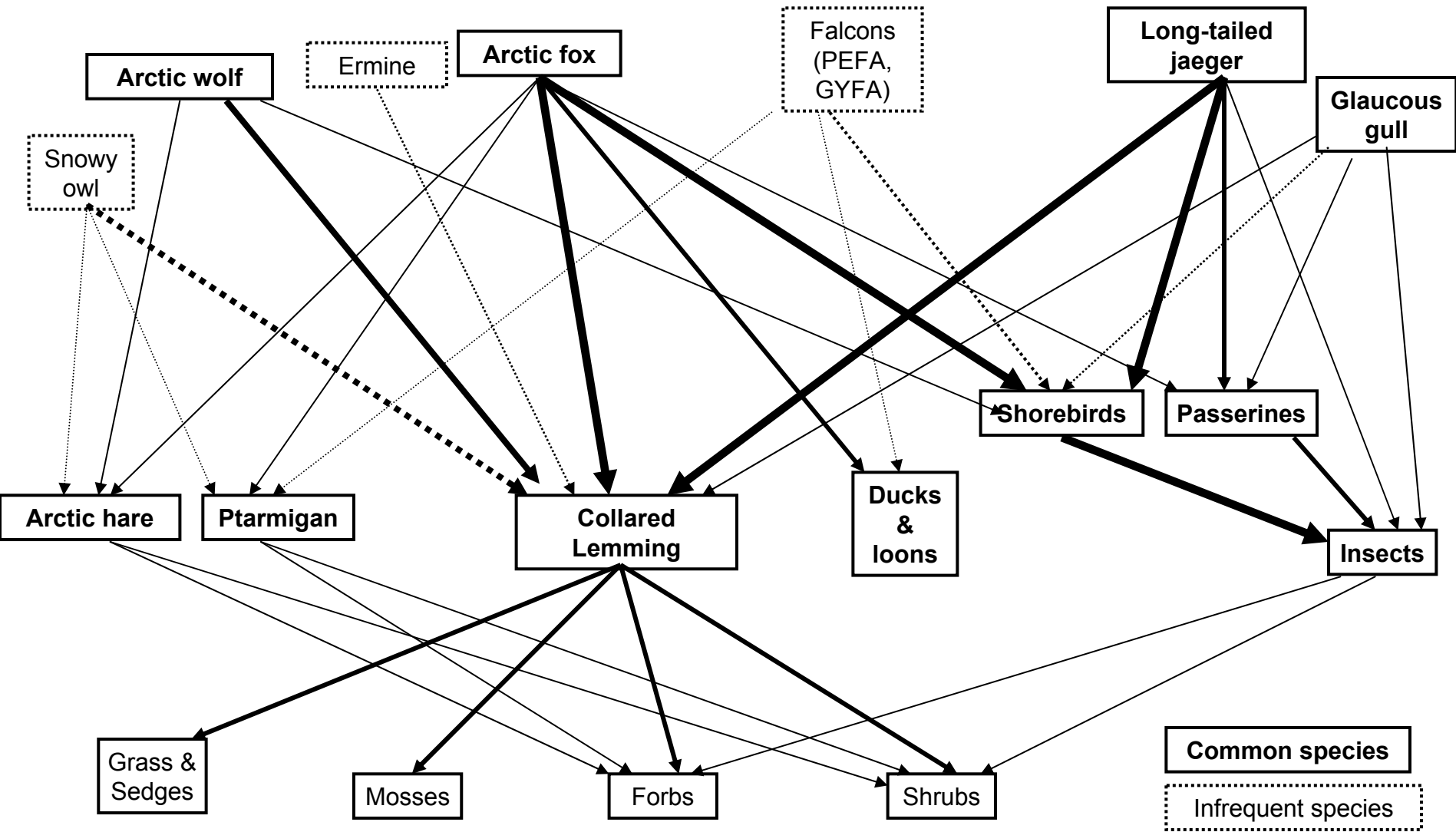

Letters associated with arrows indicate that only eggs (e), goslings (g), ducklings (d) or adults (a) are transferred. The observed transfer between caribou (newly-born calf) and both arctic foxes and bald eagles may have been scavenging.
